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THE BACK GROUND

The Public sector in Europe

According to an estimate by the **European Commission**, each year, more than 250 000 EU

public authorities spend 14% of their GDP (gross
domestic product) on the purchase of services,
works and supplies. Therefore, public administration
entities in many sectors (such as energy, healthcare and
education) should be considered as principal buyers.
Against this background, creating a new legal
framework for public procurement processes has been
defined as a priority for European Union authorities.



One of the main goals of the European Union is to ensure an open, competitive and well-regulated European market. As a result, EU legislation is focused on providing transparency, equal rights, and sound procedural management to all parties involved.

E-invoicing in public procurement should be considered as one of the most important initiatives in EU regulations. Not only will modern, digital solutions help optimize and clarify public spending, European entrepreneurs will also get simplified access to public procurement processes.

THE MOST IMPORTATNT LEGAL INITIATIVE TAKEN
BY THE EUROPEAN UNION IS DIRECTIVE 2014/55/EU.



On April 16th, 2014, both the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union officially adopted E-Invoicing Directive 2014/55/EU, which states that all European Public Administration entities are **obliged** to receive and process STRUCTURED electronic invoices sent by their suppliers. Considering the fact that nearly 400 billion invoices are issued each year, integrating electronic invoicing solutions with business strategies will allow European companies to significantly reduce operational costs and overcome market blockers in public procurement processes.

Compliance deadlines:

18th April 2019 - European **CENTRAL AND FEDERAL** administration authorities

18th April 2020 - European **REGIONAL AND LOCAL** administration authorities

It is a file created in the format specified by the new regulations, and which can be processed automatically by relevant accounting systems:











Structured e-invoices contain core system elements that are compliant with legal regulations of different countries.

Those elements are essential for enabling full interoperability during cross-border business operations.





What is OpenPEPPOL?

OpenPEPPOL is a non-profit international association that manages the development and maintenance of the PEPPOL Network. A PEPPOL-based solution can be used by a company to send and receive e-invoices using one of the certified PEPPOL Access Points.


Based on a four-corner model, PEPPOL enables business partners to exchange electronic documents using developed **Business Interopeability Specifications (BIS)** and **UBL - Universal Business Language**.

What are PEPPOL Access Points?

PEPPOL Access Points are e-invoicing solution providers who offer services fully compliant with the PEPPOL Network requirements. If a company is a certified PEPPOL Access Point, all clients can exchange their electronic documents with other participants of the network.

In practice, a supplier using an Access Point sends documents to the recipient. The Access Point, responsible for correct document transmission, is obliged to ensure **compliance with the PEPPOL specifications**. The document is sent to the recipient's Access Point in charge of document translation for its client. Both buyers and suppliers are free to choose their Access Point provider.






EDI - Robust Electronic Communication


EDI (electronic data interchange) is a **technology that enables the exchange of dozens of message types converted in accordance with the specifications of systems used by third parties.** Companies who use EDI solutions can easily communicate with all domestic and foreign business partners, exchanging not only invoices but also other types of electronic documents that cover the whole procurement process. These documents include e-orders, e-advance shipping notes, e-invoices, e-catalogs, etc.

EDI solutions that are fully compliant with the PEPPOL specifications are primary tools for **fast**, **reliable**, **interoperable invoice exchange** with all parties belonging to the PEPPOL network.





The new PEPPOL BIS Billing 3.0 standard has been developed, and has been mandatory since August 15, 2019. As a result, the PEPPOL BIS 2.0, 4a and 5a formats will be discontinued after December 31, 2019, and will no longer be supported in the PEPPOL eDelivery Network.



The PEPPOL Network creates an opportunity to build a single global market.

PEPPOL standards are currently used in **34 countries** including Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Singapore, and the USA. PEPPOL Authorities are located in 14 different parts of the world.

Additionally, both **India** and **Malaysia** have already announced they will be making the transition to PEPPOL in the coming months.

Based on the four-corner model, this enables trading partners to exchange standards-based electronic documents over the PEPPOL Network.








