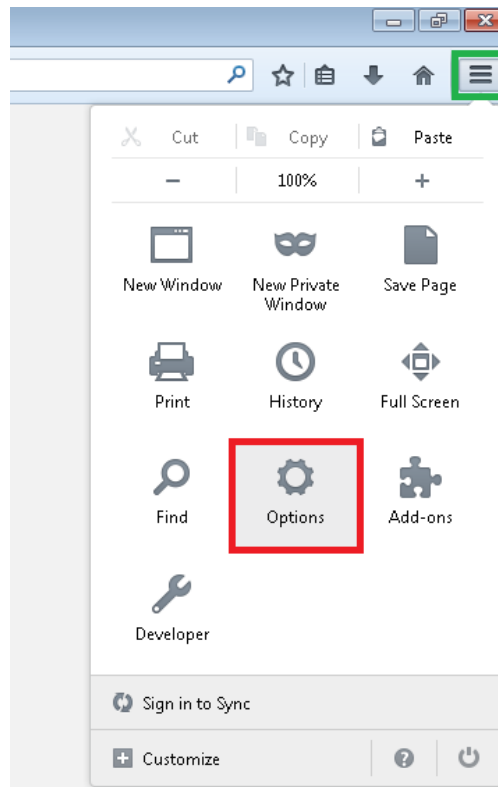
1 SAVING COMARCH CA CERTIFICATES TO FILE

The guide assumes that the certificate files of GK COMARCH ROOT CA and GK COMARCH SERVERS CA were saved from the Comarch website <https://www.comarch.pl/certyfikaty/> and can be found on your local computer.

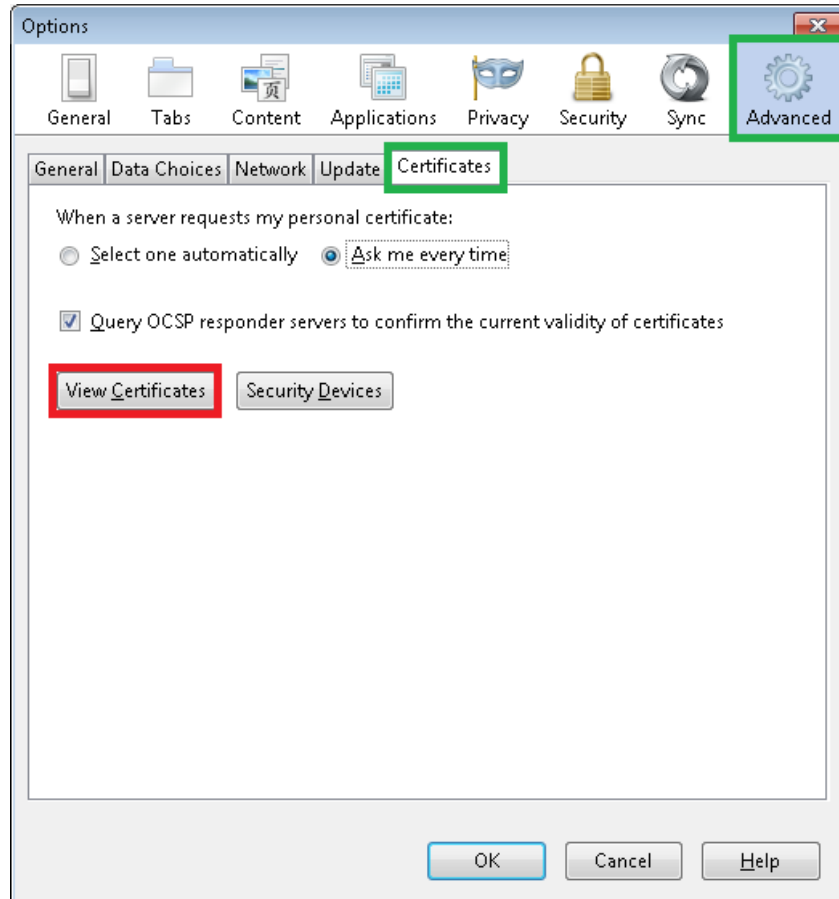
2 IMPORT CERTIFICATES INTO MOZILLA FIREFOX

In order to import ROOT Comarch CA certificates, run Mozilla Firefox.

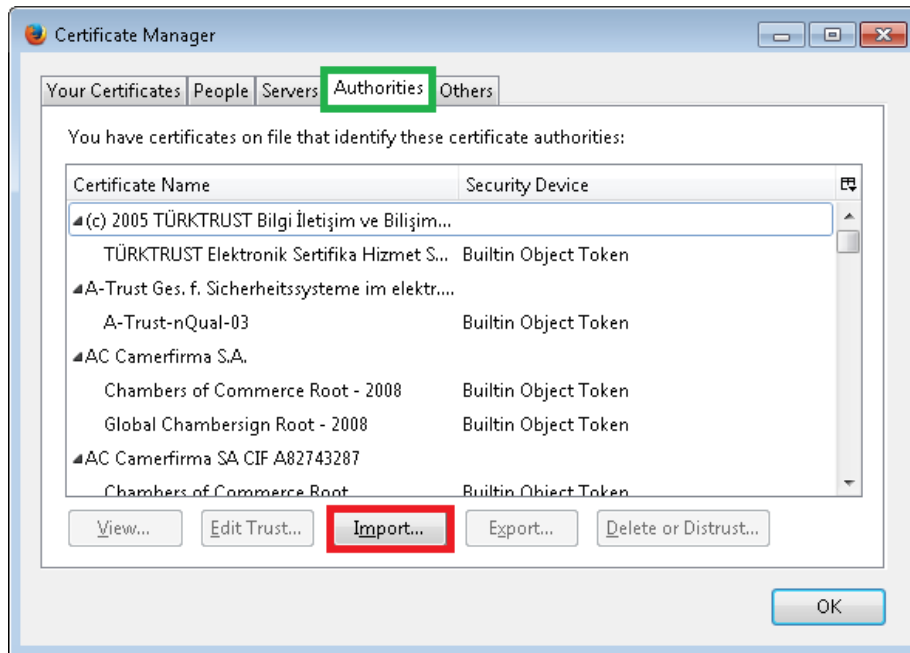
1. Click the Menu icon in upper right corner of Mozilla Firefox and next select *Options*.



2. Select *Advanced* from main section and then *Certificates* tab. Click the *View Certificates* button.



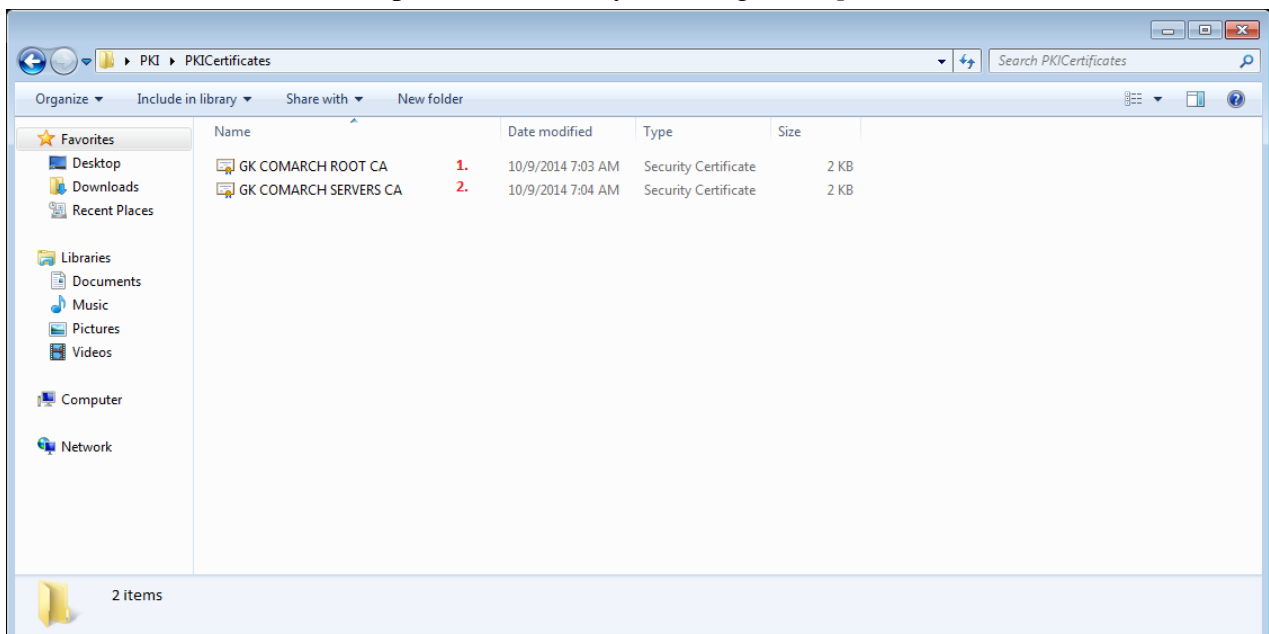
3. In next step, set *Authorities* tab and click Import...



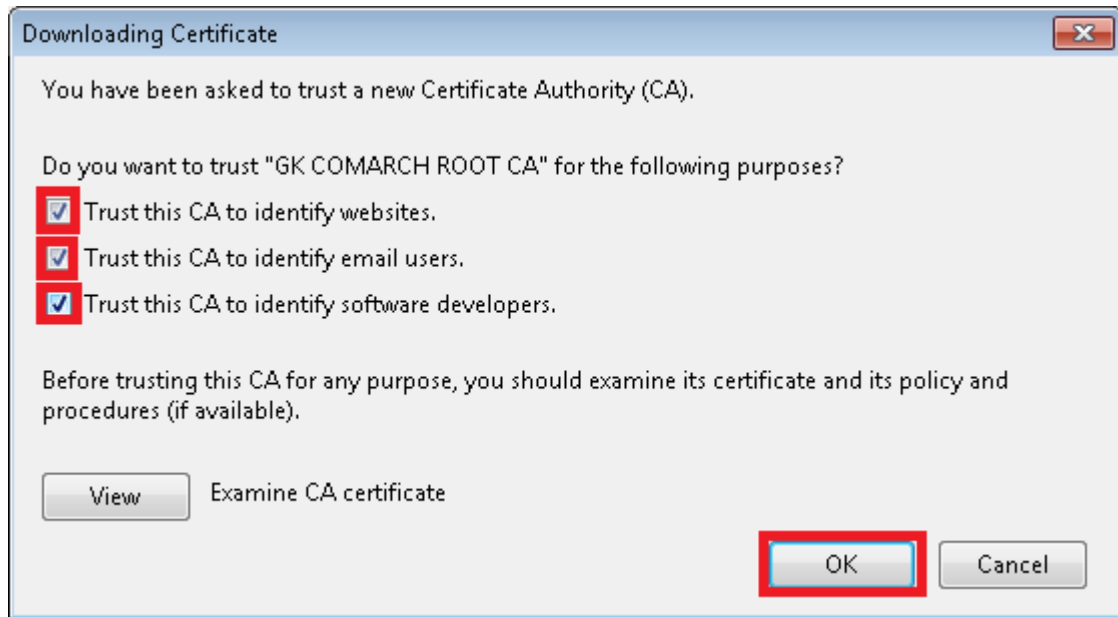
4. Import COMARCH CA certificates:

- GK COMARCH ROOT CA,
- GK COMARCH SERVERS CA.

Certificates should be imported in turn by clicking the *Open* button.



5. Select all the checkboxes. Then click the *OK* button.



6. After importing all CA certificates to *Authorities* section click the *OK* button.
